(If no children born alive write "None" in Column 7.)</i></p> <p><i>Children who have died.</i></p> <p><i>The reply should show the precise branch of Profession, Trade, Manufacture, &amp;c.</i></p> <p><i>If engaged in any Trade or Manufacture, the particular kind of work done, and the Article made or Material worked or dealt in should be clearly indicated.</i></p> <p><i>No one need be included because engaged in any Trade or Industry. (That is neither employing persons nor being employed.)</i></p> <p><i>Write the words "At Home" opposite the name of each person staying at home.</i></p> <p><i>NOTE—In the case of persons born elsewhere than in England or Wales, state whether "European" or "Visitor" in this Country.</i></p> <p><i>State whether— (1) "British subject by parentage," (2) "Naturalized British subject" giving year of naturalization, (3) "Naturalized foreign nationality," state whether "French," "German," "Russian," etc.</i></p> <p><i>If any person included in this Schedule is— (1) "Totally Blind," (2) "Totally Deaf and Dumb," (3) "Lunatic," or "Freakish minded," state the infirmity opposite that person's name, and the age at which he or she became afflicted.</i></p>
